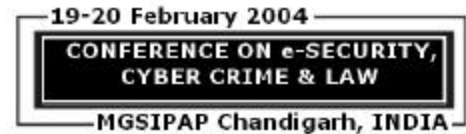

We are pleased to inform you that the Mahatma Gandhi State Institute of Public Administration, Punjab (MGSIPAP) is organizing a two day “**Conference on e-Security, Cyber Crime & Law**” on **19-20 February 2004 at Chandigarh.**

This is an opportunity to understand the legal liabilities arising from security issues, policies and procedures - beyond the “bits and bytes.” The conference will focus on presentations to address the key segments including the implementation experience, best practices, and case studies for Data Security, Cyber Crimes and Cyber Laws. - Paper Abstract: (250 words maximum).
- Detailed Paper length: (450 lines maximum).
- Brief resume (200 words maximum) of the author.
- Papers should be submitted in MS Word format, single spacing, Font Times New Roman 12, Margin 1" all around only.


SELECTION PROCESS
